Summary Report on Add-on Course

As per the decision taken by college Management and Add-on course committee the following Add-on Courses were conducted successfully for the Academic year 2017-18.

Each add-on programme was conducted for 30 hours. The curriculum content is separately framed for each course. The students of different semester are permitted to enrol add on courses of their choice. For the academic year 2017-18 there were 5 add-on courses.
