


He has published as many as 11 articles in E-journal, National and International Conferences and Seminars, also attended many Conferences and Seminars.




Photo 1: Shri Manjunath G. A. giving training on use of Manupatra

The learning outcome of the training programme is to make the students understanding of basic techniques and tools used for data collation in legal research. Developing skills of selecting appropriate techniques and their tools with best judgment in the light of objective and purpose of research. In each session students were given to search different Cases of Supreme Court, different High Courts and other Tribunals. The students were also trained to locate relevant "authority" that help in finding a solution to a legal problem or issue. Around 19 students attended the training programme.
